Application for Matching Scholarship towards tuition

EGS offers a Matching Scholarship program. Students can apply for a scholarship wherein they actively participate in raising money, which will be matched to a determined limit by the European Graduate School. The idea of the program is that the student solicits funds from sources other than bank or scholarship associations. The sources can include family (excluding same household), friends, community associations, etc.

The money can be raised from any source except a bank loan. The distribution of matching scholarship depends on available funds.

NOTE For an application to be considered, a student applying for a Matching Scholarship must have already been admitted and must have registered for summer school. Applications should be sent by email directly to the office of the European Graduate School administration@egs.edu

Deadline for the application is April 30 of the academic year on a first-come, first-served basis. Students will be informed by email after the approval by mid-May of the academic year.

The items mentioned below must be submitted by the student when applying for a Matching Scholarship:

1. Filled-in and signed „Matching Scholarship“ form
2. A copy of your tax returns for the last two years
3. A budget-plan of the academic year the scholarship is being requested (template available on request)
4. A list of real estate and other property (including vehicles)

➤ The amount to be matched that has been collected from sponsors must be transferred to the EGS bank account as a down-payment towards the student's annual tuition. A student will be considered for a matching amount towards the annual tuition, if the amount raised and the Matching-Scholarship Application is received at EGS by April 30, of the academic year. After that date, EGS cannot guarantee that funds for the Matching Scholarship will still be available. In any case, EGS can only match a partial amount of the student's tuition. The exact amount will depend on the student's financial need and on the available Matching Scholarship fund.

The sponsors may pay by Credit Card or by Bank Transfer towards the student's tuition fee as follows:
