Bring to Summer School: Your MA Testatbooklet and two paper copies of your thesis, including the abstract (100–130 words in English). One copy is for the seminar "Presentation and Oral Defense" and the other copy is for the thesis display table.

To satisfy copyright requirements, you will have to give EGS permission as follows: (Included on the thesis cover page) "Hereby I give EGS the authorization to send the Thesis file on electronic media to people who are interested in my thesis."

- Students who are provisionally accepted (do not hold a Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent) must pass the Access Exam before the qualifying third Summer School.
- The Application needs to be complete.
- Please note that the original diploma paper will only be issued if all administrative and financial matters are completed (tuition and fees for room and board).

If your thesis is in its final stages, have your thesis advisor confirm this with a request to the program director or dean to attend the exams. The student may still participate in the graduation ceremony, but will not receive the diploma. The diploma will be sent to the student after all the requirements are fulfilled.

Tuition and Fees

Students are only permitted to attend the Summer School Seminars in Saas-Fee, if the payment of application fee, tuition and room and board are fully remitted according to the payment contract mentioned in this brochure. Students applying for matching grants towards the tuition or for work study positions need to have already been admitted and must have registered for Summer School. Students applying for US or Canadian Student Loans cannot also apply for a work-study position or a matching grant.

Room and Board Reservation

Please note that registered students are not allowed to book accommodations for the stay during the EGS seminars in Saas-Fee through any facility other than the EGS partner, which is the Hotel Allalin.
